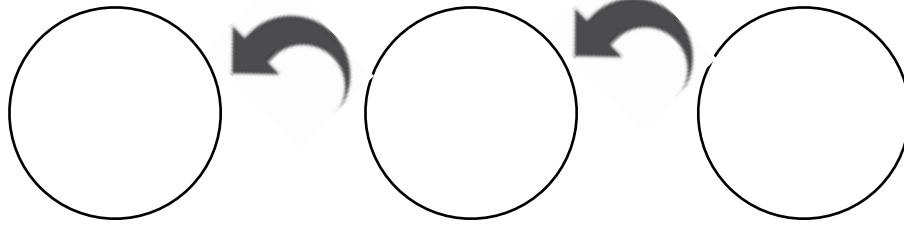


# Painting Skills- key

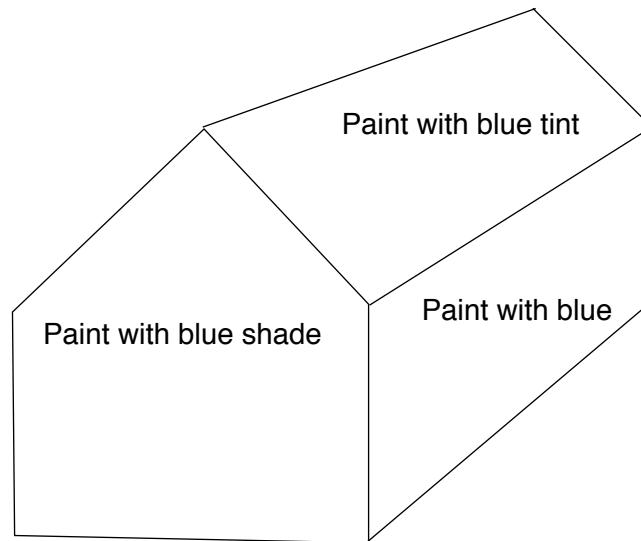
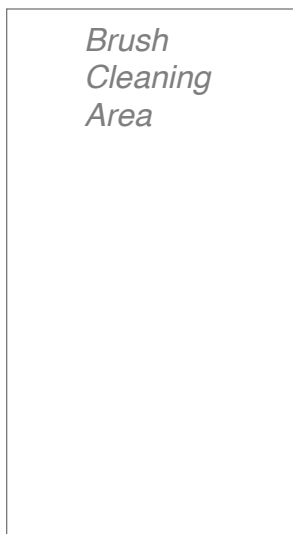
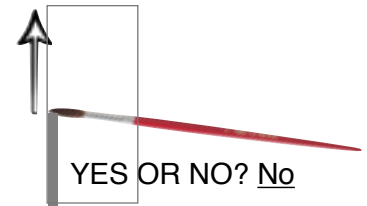
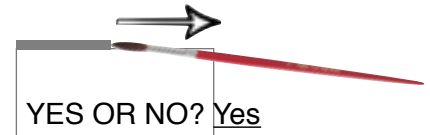
1 drop black

Adding a color to **white** is called a tint

Adding **black** to a color is called a shade

**Rule #1:** Add dark color to light color.

**Rule #2:** Edges are best painted when the brush bristles are held in the same direction as the edge being painted.

**Tip:** Colors are much more interesting if they are mixed and not taken directly from the bottle.

Red added to Yellow = orange

Blue added to Yellow = green

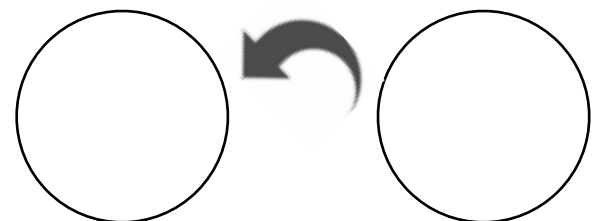
Blue added to Red = purple or violet
