Eureka City Schools (ECS) and Klamath Trinity Joint Unified School District (KTJUSD) agree to a partnership for coordination of the North Coast Arts Integration Project (NCAIP) during 2016-17 and 2017-18 school year. To achieve the goals of the project:

CS and KT Teachers will:

- 1. Participate in 36 hours of NCAIP professional development.
- 2. Complete beginning and end of year questionnaire.
- 3. Participate in collaboration and classroom follow-up discussions with NCAIP staff.
- 4. Attend monthly meetings during 2017-18.
- 5. Implement at least 1 arts integration lesson or strategy per month.
- 6. Submit one reflection or assignment per month during 2017-18.
- 7. Allow classroom data collection by NCAIP staff to occur several times per year.
- 8. Maintain timely email communication with program staff.
- 9. (Site leaders will) help to schedule and organize monthly meetings
- 10. (Site leaders will) deliver one professional development or write an arts integration lesson plan
- 11. (Site leaders will)-be contact person/ organize activities as needed.
- 12. (Site leaders will) be the liaison with the tech department as needs arise with the tablets

ff will:

- 1. Provide stipends to teachers who complete the requirements of the project and prorated stipends to those who do not. Specifically, \$500 for each participating teacher to be paid in June 2017, and June 2018. Site Leaders will receive an additional \$500 in December 2017.
- 2. Provide professional development, facilitate collaborations with teaching / visiting artists and support classroom arts integration projects.
- 3. Maintain participation records of all participating teachers.

- 4. Provide participating teachers a tablet computer for professional use to keep after completion of 2 years in the project.
- Support student learning and teacher participation in the project by facilitating teaching practice reflection.
